



# World InterUniversities Championships®

## General Rules

### *In each sport Championships:*

- Teams cannot share players within the same competition. No player can play with two teams in the same competition. The sanction will be the loss of both matches in which he/she played.
- Teams are urged to be present at least 15 minutes before their scheduled matches at the assigned sport facilities, and report to the person in charge of the corresponding competition.
- Please note that assigned times are match start times and any delay of more than 5 minutes after the starting time of the match will be automatically penalized with the loss of that match.
- Matches will be conducting in running time, due to the tightness of the Schedules.
- Any disrespectful attitude towards the referee(s), table official(s) or opponents will be automatically penalized with the loss of the match.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to disqualify any player, coach, official or follower from these events if found to be in infraction of the rules and regulations set for these Championships.
- It is absolutely forbidden to perform any political claims during the events.

## Staff

All teams must treat tournament staff with respect (referees, table officials and organization staff).

All tournament staff members also understand that they have the same obligations towards all participants.

All sanctions resulting from any infraction(s) will be decided by the “World InterUniversities Championships” Organizing Committee.

## Awards Ceremony

### FOR EACH CHAMPIONSHIP:

#### **1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE:**

TROPHY + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS + CHEQUE of 500 euro to be used for the registration to the 5<sup>th</sup> World InterUniversities Championships (for football male, futsal male and female, basketball male and female, volleyball male and female, handball male and female, rugby 7's male, swimming mix, cheerleading dance contest).

TROPHY + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS + CHEQUE of 300 euro to be used for the registration to the 4<sup>th</sup> World InterUniversities Championships (for tennis, tennis table, badminton).

#### **1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE:**

TROPHY + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS (for rugby 7's female, waterpolo male, chess)

**2<sup>ND</sup> - 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE:** CUP + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS

**4<sup>TH</sup> PLACE:** CUP

**Tennis, Tennis Table and Badminton: Individual Male, Individual Female and Mixed Doubles Tournaments** will have the Awards Ceremony directly on the field with medals at the end of each event and later, the best 4 Universities (in the summation of the 3 tournaments), will be rewarded also during the Awards Ceremony, at the end of all the Championships.

**Swimming:** The Swimming Championship is a “Team Championship”, meaning that the final results are composed of the summation of all the competitions (there will be no individual awards).

**Rugby 7's female, Waterpolo male and Chess:** are Promotional Sport and will not carry any points for the Best Universities Ranking.

**Rugby 7's female, Waterpolo male:** in case of at least 8 teams, it will pass to a Championships level

### **BEST UNIVERSITIES RANKING**

Contribution to be used for the registration to the 5<sup>th</sup> World Inter-Universities Championships:

Best University in the Championships: 1.500 euro

2<sup>nd</sup> University: 800 euro

3<sup>rd</sup> University: 600 euro

4<sup>th</sup> University: 500 euro

5<sup>th</sup> University: 400 euro

Criteria: For each Championship sport, the winning team(s) will be awarded (gain):

- 1<sup>ST</sup> place - 10 POINTS;
- 2<sup>ND</sup> - 7 POINTS;
- 3<sup>RD</sup> - 5 POINTS;
- 4<sup>TH</sup> - 3 POINTS
- 5<sup>th</sup> place - 6<sup>th</sup> place - 7<sup>th</sup> place - 8<sup>th</sup> place: 1 POINT
