



# World InterUniversities Championships®

## Badminton Championships Official Rules

The organization of the “World InterUniversities Championships” shall be mainly based on the most recent Technical Regulations of the Badminton World Federation (BWF).

3 tournaments:

- Men’s Single: qualification round pools. Then, matches will be played as knock-out system
- Ladies’ Single: qualification round pools. Then, matches will be played as knock-out system
- Mixed Doubles: matches will be played as knock-out system

WIUC Badminton Regulations  
without prejudice to the general rules BE and BWF,

The match is played at the best of three games.  
The game is won by the side that first reaches 15 points,  
If the score is 14 all, the side that takes the lead by two points wins the game.  
If the score is 20 all, the side that scores the 21st point wins the game.

The finals will be played to 21 points.  
The match is played at the best of three games.  
The game is won by the side that first reaches 21 points,  
If the score is 20-all, the side that takes the lead by two points wins the game.  
If the score is 29 all, the side that scores the 30th point wins the game.

On Thursday 11th the qualifications of the individual Women's and Men's will be played.  
On Friday there will be the single elimination draws of the men's and women's singles and mixed doubles up to the quarter-finals.  
The semifinals of the men's and women's singles and mixed doubles will be played on Saturday, the finals 1st and 2nd place and 3rd and 4th of all disciplines.

## Awards and Points

### Individual Male, Individual Female and Double Mix Tournaments

The first, second and third placed in each tournament, will be awarded with medals, directly on site at the end of the competition.

### Overall Badminton World InterUniversities Champion (Team):

The Best 4 Universities in the summation of the 3 tournaments, will be awarded also during the Awards Ceremony, at the end of all the Championships.

#### . **Criteria:**

In each individual tournament, only the best athlete of each University will receive points for the final result.

Also in the mixed doubles, only the best team from each University will receive points for the final result.

Points: 1<sup>st</sup> 10 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> 7 p.; 3<sup>rd</sup> 5 p.; 4<sup>th</sup> 3 p.; 5<sup>th</sup> 1 p.; 6<sup>th</sup> 1 p.; 7<sup>th</sup> 1 p.; 8<sup>th</sup> 1 p.

#### . **Awards:**

1<sup>st</sup> Place: Trophy + a CHEQUE of 300 euros to be used for the registration in the “5<sup>th</sup>World InterUniversities Championships”

2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> places: cup

Also: The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes, of any nature, including change in times, if they are in the best interest of the Championships. Teams will obviously be notified of the changes in time. All players must take note of the rules of the game including the aforementioned exceptions.
