## Tennis Table Championships Official Rules

3 tournaments:

- Men's Single
- Women's Single
- Mixed Doubles

Best of 5 matches system ; 11 points per set

Anything not in these rules, The ITTF (International Table Tennis Federation) rules competition will be followed.
4 Tables: Cornilleau Sport 250
Balls: Joola Prime 40+***

## Competition

## Men Singles (MS)

11 players
$1^{\text {st }}$ stage ( 2 groups of 4 and 1 group of 3 ): $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ from the group of 4 qualify for the second stage, as well as $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ from the groups of 3 .
$2^{\text {nd }}$ stage: knock out system

## Women Singles (WS)

10 players
$1^{\text {st }}$ stage: ( 2 groups of 5 ) $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ of each group qualifies for the second stage
$2^{\text {nd }}$ stage: knock out system ( $1^{\text {st }}$ groups bye first round)
Mixed Doubles (XD)
8 doubles
Knock out system.

## Awards and Points

Individual Male, Individual Female and Mixed Doubles Tournaments

The first, second and third placed in each tournament, will be rewarded with medals, directly on site at the end of the competition.

Overall Tennis Table World InterUniversities Champion (Team):
The Best 4 Universities in the summation of the 3 tournaments, will be rewarded also during the Awards Ceremony, at the end of all the Championships.

## Criteria:

In each individual tournament, only the best athlete of each University will receive points for the final result. Also in the mixed doubles, only the best team from each University will receive points for the final result. Note : points will be assigned starting from the knock-out matches

Points: $1^{\text {st }} 10$ points; $2^{\text {nd }} 7$ p.; $3^{\text {rd }} 5$ p.; $4^{\text {th }} 3$ p.; $5^{\text {th }} 1$ p.; $6^{\text {th }} 1$ p.; $7^{\text {th }} 1$ p.; $8^{\text {th }} 1$ p.

## Awards:

$1^{\text {st }}$ Place: Trophy + a CHEQUE of 300 euros to be used for the registration in the " 8 th World InterUniversities Championships"
$2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ places: cup
Also: The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes, of any nature, including change in times, if they are in the best interest of the Championships. Teams will obviously be notified of the changes in time. All players must take note of the rules of the game including the aforementioned exceptions.
